Endoscope Reprocessing Protocols

TIMELY REPROCESSING

There are several stages in the reprocessing cycle and there are time specific considerations that must be observed in order to mitigate risk to the patient & maximize the ability to properly clean & high level disinfect the instrument

Timely reprocessing =

- 1) DEFINED TIMELINES IN STANDARD or....
- 2) TIMELINE THAT IS EXECUTED ACCORDING TO FACILITY POLICY & PROCEDURE IF NOT SPECIFIED IN THE STANDARD

Canadian Standards Association states:

The precise time frame within which various endoscope reprocessing activities should take place has not been scientifically established. Table 2 provides some guidelines based on a consensus of expert opinion.

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There are some key stages defined in the standards today that must be observed:

- Preclean needs to be done immediately after the instrument is removed from the patient
- Time between preclean including transportation and manual cleaning must be less or equal to 1hr

Note: if this time is >3hrs then alternate methods must be executed

 Endoscope must be removed within 1 hour of the endoscope reprocessing high level disinfection cycle being complete
