In 2000, ASP introduced the Award of Excellence in Medical Device Reprocessing to recognize contributions to the Medical Device Reprocessing Profession by non-management Reprocessing Technicians. We did this because based on our observations while working with you in your hospital; it was evident that the front line workers significantly influenced change in medical device reprocessing. This must be over and above their paid position or union position.

Please consider nominating one of your peers or employees who have been involved in special projects, teaching, motivating or mentoring others, and developing or implementing innovative ideas. I would venture to guess that you have one of these people in your department. Thanks for taking the time to recognize these special people.

This award is to recognize contributions made to the medical device reprocessing profession by non- management-reprocessing technicians (front line staff).

The Award: One thousand dollars used to attend the conference for continuing education, contributing to their career development in MDRD. This may include MDRD conference registration, expenses, materials, etc.

When: The award presented at the Bi-annual MDRAO Conference Awards Dinner on Saturday at the 2019 conference.

Eligibility: 1) Current member in good standing of MDRAO 2018/2019

- 2) Nominated by a Manager, Supervisor or Peer.
- 3) Must attend the 2019 conference.
- 4) Must work as staff in reprocessing department not the operating room.
- 5) Cannot have won the award before.

Assessment: The categories used in assessing the nominations for ASP Award of Excellence are as follows: (Please provide demonstrated examples and outcomes)

Process Change - Has the individual contributed to changes in process in the department or in other areas of the hospital?

Teaching Mentoring - Does the individual contribute to the teaching process in the department or hospital?

Innovation - Has the individual taken the initiative to implement change through a process that was not attempted before or challenges the status quo?

Quality Improvement - has the individual improved the quality of the services provided by MDRD by his or her actions?
