**Position:** MDR Technician

**Description:**

The MDR Technician reports to the Coordinator, Sterile Processing Department and is responsible for cleaning, assembling, packaging and sterilization of all instruments and supplies for the operating room and floors. This position involves the handling of a wide variety of complicated instruments. The environment can be challenging due to tight time pressures, the need to be precise in handling instruments and the potential impact on patient care. The position is physically demanding, requiring lifting, pushing, pulling, bending and standing.

Shifts are scheduled as required by unit and subject to change in accordance with the Collective Agreement.
